This prestigious prize for children's literature aims to cultivate in the young generation values of honesty, self-confidence, the love of one's land, tolerance, good deeds and the pleasure of reading.

The prize's published stories were shortlisted among hundreds of stories submitted from all the Arab World. The committee of judges included writers and specialists from all over the Arab world highly renowned for their level of excellence and expertise. And so stories came to life considerate to the language grammar rules, the smooth flow of ideas, the sound language and text, the social and psychological liaison, and the richness in ethics such as love, the integrity and acceptance of one another.
