Dr. Abdulkhaleq Abdulla, a UAE national born in 1953, is a professor of Political Science at Emirates University. He is the chairman of the cultural committee at the Dubai Cultural and Scientific Association and a member of the Global Agenda Council on Population Growth. He was a member of the Dubai Cultural Council, the General Coordinator of the Gulf Development Forum, director of the research center at AlKhaleej newspaper, editor of the Gulf Strategic Report, editor of the Journal of Social Affairs and the lead author of the Arab Knowledge Report 2008. He is the recipient of the Cultural Personality of the Year 2005 Award and Taryam Omran Intellectual Pioneer 2010 Award. He holds PhD in Political science from Georgetown University and MA from American University in Washington D.C. He was a Fulbright Scholar and a visiting professor at the Center for Contemporary Arab Studies, Georgetown University. He attended seminars and lectured in universities and research centers around the world including the United States, Europe, the Arab World, Australia and Japan. Professor Abdulla is a frequent commentator in the media on current Arab and Gulf affairs. His research interests include issues of political changes in the Gulf and the Arab World, Gulf Security, contemporary issues of Arab Gulf States and international relations. Professor Abdulla is the author of several books including, Narrative of Politics, 2006 and the Gulf Regional System 2006. He has published more than 40 articles, the latest is the "Sociopolitical Issues of the Arab Gulf Moment" published by the London School of Economics 2010.
