Olivier Brousse has been CEO of SAUR S.A, since June 2008.

SAUR is the third French environmental company, founded in 1933, managing water and waste services for public authorities in France and abroad.

- Prior to that position, he spent 14 years with Veolia Environment, working mainly in the Public Transportation division.
- Between 2003 and 2007, Olivier Brousse lived in Washington DC, where he was CEO of Veolia Transportation Inc. , which he helped grow from \$ 200 M annual revenue, to \$ 1 Billion and 17,000 employees, running mass transit systems on behalf of public authorities.
- Between 1998 and 2003, Olivier Brousse lived in London, UK, where he ran one of the privatized train companies, Connex South Eastern.
- Graduated from Ecole Polytechnique and Ecole des Ponts et Chaussées.
- Member of the Aspen Institute and the Henry Crown Fellowship.
- Olivier Brousse is now 48 and lives in Paris.
